
MTV Real World House on Lombard Street Facing Foreclosure

The house rented by MTV back in 1994 for the third season of "<u>The Real World, San Francisco</u>" is now facing foreclosure. Located at <u>949-953 Lombard St, San Francisco, CA, 94133</u>, the owner reportedly owes \$3,715,730 in <u>unpaid mortgage payments</u>, prompting the foreclosure filing.

In addition to its MTV stardom, the house was the site of a major fire in 2000. According to the <u>San Francisco</u> Chronicle:

The fire started on the second floor at 3:20 a.m. and spread to the third floor before firefighters controlled it a half- hour later, said Fire Lt. Ed Campbell. The fire, which may have been started by an unattended candle, is being investigated as an accident.

Six residents were living in the house as part of a Real World-esque internet web cam show, sponsored by <u>SpotLife</u>. The house sustained \$2 million in damage during the fire.

The house has since become a major tourist attaction on Lombard Street, famous for being <u>America's crookedest street</u>. The steep, hilly street was created with eight sharp curves that switchback down the one-way hill.
